ORDER

S. R. O.....(I)/2010.-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to order that:-

- (a) export of cotton yarn is allowed to the extent of fifty million kilogram per month with immediate effect and till the 30th June, 2010;
- (b) the export is allowed subject to registration of export contract by Trade Development Authority of Pakistan (TDAP);
- (c) the monthly ceiling of fifty million kilograms shall not apply to export of following yarn, namely:
 - (i) lycra;
 - (ii) dyed;
 - (iii) heather grey or mélange;
 - (iv) slub; or
 - (v) bleached or singed;

Provided the exporting units are registered with the Ministry of Textile Industry and the consignments are certified, to be any of those specified in sub-clauses (i) to (v), by accredited laboratories.



Islamabad, the 8th January 2010Office Memorandum**SUBJECT: Decision of the Cabinet Committee on Textiles**

In the Cabinet Committee on Textiles meeting held on 8-1-2010 the situation prevailing in the domestic market and export of cotton yarn was reviewed and after considering all factors including the export trends, the availability of cotton yarn for domestic industry and the prevalent prices, it was decided that measures consistent with GATT, 1994 are required to be taken to ensure that the value added sector is not deprived of its comparative advantage due to inadequate availability of yarn.

2. The Committee, therefore, took the following decisions:-

- i. Export of cotton yarn upto 32 counts would be capped at a monthly volume of 50 million Kg during the current crop season and export contracts will be registered by the TDAP on first come, first-served basis. This measure would stand terminated on 30-06-2010.
- ii. The following yarns would be excluded from the above cap which shall only be exported by units registered with the Ministry of Textile Industry after producing proper certificates from accredited laboratories for each consignment:
 - a) Lycra
 - b) Dyed
 - c) Heather Grey/ Melange
 - d) Slub
 - e) Bleached/singed

3. The Ministry of Commerce is requested to urgently issue the necessary SRO for implementation of the above decision. It is also requested that a strict monitoring mechanism may be devised jointly by the TDAP and the Customs to ensure that exports are allowed only against contracts duly registered with the Trade Development of Pakistan (TDAP).
