

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SUBJECT: MINUTES OF MEETING OF PROGRESS ON STUDY OF THE PAKISTAN TEXTILE & CLOTHING INDUSTRY FOR PERSPECTIVE PLAN

A meeting with Textile Trade Associations to review and expedite submission of the completed questionnaires for perspective plan of Pakistan Textile & Clothing Industry was held in the Committee Room of Textile Commissioner's Organization on 05.11.2008 at 11:00 a.m. under the Chairmanship of Textile Commissioner. The Meeting started with recitation of the Holy Quran. The list of participants is annexed.

2. The Textile Commissioner welcomed the participants and gave brief history about the study. After that Mr. Zeeshan Ali Siddiqui, Director (TUG), gave presentation about the Perspective Plan with emphasize that more focus should be given to value addition of the Textile Products in order to survive and grow in an increasingly competitive environment.

3. Textile Commissioner raised his concern about the poor participation of Trade Associations in the study and said that most of the Associations and their selected member units did not submit the completed questionnaires even after many reminders. He added that all Associations will have to take ownership in order to get required information for the successful completion of such study.

4. Mr. Saleem Parekh, Representative of PHMA, agreed with Textile Commissioner's point of view and said that it was the responsibility of Associations to provide completed questionnaires to the Consultant which is not being accomplished due to lack of interest of Associations regarding the study.

5. Textile Commissioner appreciated the efforts of TMA to provide completed questionnaires of their all selected member units and said that any Association who is not willing to participate in the study must inform this office in writing.

6. Mr. Yaseen Siddik, representative of APTMA raised the issue of utilities problem which is affecting the productivity of Textile Industry. Textile Commissioner replied that MINTEX is eager to cooperate and facilitate the Textile Industry in all possible manners but the corporate sectors should also make efforts by formulating different strategies in order to survive/grow in such conditions.

Decision Taken:

“The Associations who could not submit the completed questionnaire of Associations and companies to M/s Gherzi Textile requested to extend the cut off date from 10th to 20th November 2008 to follow up with their members to provide the data. The request was accepted with the instructions that all Associations would furnish the required information to the consultant under intimation to this office within specified date”.

7. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
