

**ORDER**

**S.R.O 119 (I)/2010.-** In exercise of powers conferred under sub section (1) of section 3 of the Imports & Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), and in suppression of its Order, notified vide Notification No. S.R.O. 26 (I)/2010, dated the 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2010, the Federal Government in pleased to direct that \_\_\_\_\_

- (a) export of yarn will be restricted to 35 million kilo gram per month for all types of yarn for the next four months from 1<sup>st</sup> March to 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2010;
- (b) vaule added yarn fetching a price more than or equal to \$3.5 per kilo gram will be allowed over and above the quota only to those units which are registered with the Ministry of Textile Industry as value-added exporters and within limits of their assessed capacities as determined by the Ministry of Textile Industry; and
- (c) export shall be monitored by Customs on actual shipment and first-come-first served basis and registration with Trade Development Authority (TDAP) shall be dispensed with.
