Sales tax likely to be reduced on hybrid vehicles

ISLAMABAD: The government is planning to reduce sales tax from 25 percent to 18 percent on the import and local supply of hybrid vehicles. It is learnt that a summary has been moved to the Finance Division in this regard.

BMP slams govt's decision of daily fuel pricing mechanism

LAHORE: The Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry's Businessmen Panel (BMP) has strongly condemned the government's decision to introduce a daily petroleum pricing mechanism, describing it as an anti-industry, anti-business and anti-public measure that will further fuel inflation, undermine business confidence and increase uncertainty across the economy.

Marginal gain momentum

KARACHI: The Pakistani rupee continued its marginal gain against the US dollar for another week, appreciating 0.03 percent in the inter-bank market. The local unit closed at 277.96 against the greenback, a gain of Re0.09 from 278.05 it had closed at a week earlier.

Weekly Cotton Review: Production surges 77pc despite textile sector woes

KARACHI: Pakistan's cotton production has surged by 77 percent, reaching five hundred and twenty-eight thousand bales so far, even as the textile industry grapples with rising input costs, falling seed cotton supplies, and mounting closures of local mills that industry leaders warn could deepen unemployment across the sector.
