Pakistan to sell excess LNG in international markets from Jan 1: minister

KARACHI: Petroleum Minister Ali Pervaiz Malik said on Sunday that Pakistan would begin selling excess LNG in international markets from January 1. Malik's statement during a press conference in Lahore came months after it was reported that Pakistan was exploring ways to sell excess LNG cargoes amid a gas supply glut that could cost domestic producers millions in annual losses.

EDS: Businesses say decision to boost exports

PESHAWAR: Members of the business community welcomed the government's decision to abolish 0.25 percent export development surcharge (EDS), stating that it would boost exports and to ease exporters' cost pressure and enhance competitiveness in the global market.

Marginal gain for another week

Weekly Cotton Review: Prices remain stable amid low level of trading activity

KARACHI: Quality cotton prices remained stable although trading volume stayed limited. The spot rate recorded an increase of one hundred rupees per maund. Cotton production reached five million one hundred thirty-four thousand bales while total production is expected to reach approximately five million five hundred thousand bales.
